## The status and prospects of project based mitigation activities after Paris

### Pre-2020 support for stranded projects and implications of Article 6

Monday, May 22 2017, 15:30 to 18:00

Innovate4Climate, Barcelona, Side Event Room 4

Article 6 of the Paris Agreement establishes a new framework for international carbon market mechanisms. However, considerable uncertainty remains how many countries will use international project based credits both before and beyond 2020, and whether already implemented mitigation activities will be supported. This event will present findings and open discussion on **the extent to which different types of existing CDM projects, in specific countries, are at risk of discontinuing GHG abatement**, and the **potential for supporting the continuation of those projects at risk**. Based on the assessment of project discontinuation risk, and building on previous analysis on the status of existing CDM projects, speakers will also discuss new findings on the **realistic CER supply potential in the period up to 2020**. These questions have high relevance for policy makers aiming to close the pre-2020 mitigation gap by supporting existing CDM projects as well as for international negotiations on international market-based mechanisms under the Paris Agreement and post-2020 programmes such as ICAO's CORSIA.

The event will focus around a series of short presentations to prepare the ground for discussions with the audience. Interventions from experts representing both the supply and demand sides of crediting for project based mitigation activities will challenge the research results, to allow for an in-depth exploration of key questions and topics.
